- **Advances national objectives** – by boosting productivity and economic growth, promoting a cleaner environment, or strengthening your community;
- **Supports long-term planning** – by building capacity for planning and asset management, addressing long-term needs, or generating long-lasting benefits;
- **Addresses local needs** – by creating wide-ranging community benefits that meet the diverse needs of multiple residents and businesses; and
- **Demonstrates excellence** – in design or execution, by adopting an innovative, efficient or effective approach to address local needs and achieve outcomes.

The Committee may select up to three winners. Winners will be notified in June.
